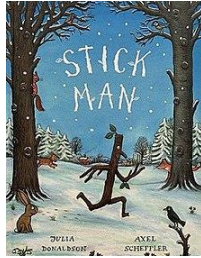

Maths

- **Activity 1** Collect some sticks. Are they different lengths? E.g. longer, shorter. Can you put them in order of length? Can you measure each stick, how long are they? You can use any form of measurement. E.g. how many pennies long are they?
- **Activity 2** What else can you measure? How long are your feet?
- **Activity 3** Choose an object, e.g. a spoon. Can you find something longer than the spoon? Can you find something shorter than the spoon?

More Ideas...

- Stick Lady Love and her stick children three were very happy to see Stickman come home at the end. What makes you happy?
- When you're out walking what natural resources can you find? Sticks, pinecones, leaves. What can you use them for?
Can you create a map of all the places stick man visits or might visit?
- Discuss what adventures a different stickman might go on. Count up how many places they will go to.
