


Male blackbird snapper



You will need:

- glue
- yellow, orange and dark brown colouring pencils
- double-sided tape.

What to do:

- 1 Colour both halves of the beak and the outer circle around the eye orange. Make the inside of the mouth yellow. Colour the inside of the eye dark brown.
- **2** Cut out the blackbird snapper.
- **3** Fold the snapper along the dotted lines with the coloured area facing outwards. Make sure you fold across the middle of the mouth too.
- **4** Apply glue as marked. Match A and B glued sections under the head and beak, squeezing to stick in place.
- **5** Inside the beak where circles are marked, stick a piece of double-sided tape. Put your fingers on the tape and start snapping!
