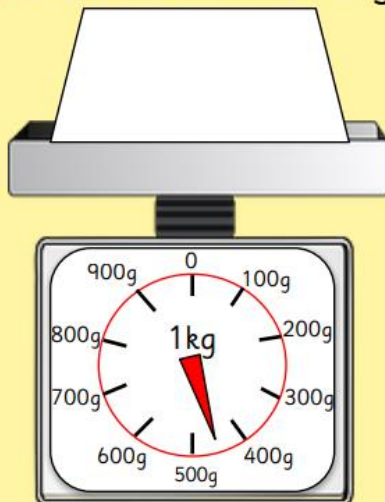


Digging Deeper

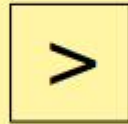
