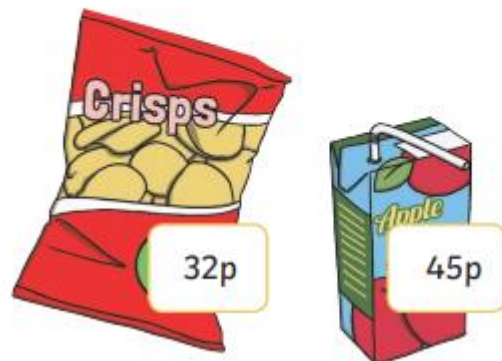
Jack buys a packet of crisps and a drink. How much do they cost altogether?
