Questions and follow up:

- Who is the author of this story? (Eric Carle)
- Has this author written any other books that you have read or listened to? (The Very Hungry Caterpillar, The Very Busy Spider, The Very Lazy Ladybird....)
- How is this story similar to The Very Hungry Caterpillar? (they both pop out of an egg at the beginning of the story, and there is a caterpillar eating an apple in the story)
- In the story there is a 'lunar moth', what does the word 'lunar' mean? Can you find out?
- There is a special word we use for animals that come out at night can you find out what it is? (nocturnal)
- How do you think the cricket felt when he couldn't speak to the other animals?
- Can you make up a story about the very busy spider, the very quiet cricket and the very hungry caterpillar all meeting each other? You could create your own finger or stick puppets to help you tell the story.
